The CNA Course

Students receive instruction in human anatomy and physiology, basic nursing skills, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), medical terminology, emergency care, infection control and safe clinical practices. Students' ethical and legal responsibilities will be integrated throughout the course. Successful completion of both course content and supervised clinical care will result in satisfaction of criteria required by the Nevada State Board of Nursing for the Nursing Assistant Program.

Requirements for Nurse Assistant Training

- The first day of class you must bring valid picture ID, Social Security card and resume
- NO felony background
- Able to lift 50 lbs.
- Required High School diploma or GED/High School Equivalency
