The Phlebotomy Course

Students receive instruction in blood draw and prepare blood for medical testing, transfusions or donation. Students will also receive instruction in the collection of blood via venipuncture, finger pricks, or in the case of infants, heel pricks.

Requirements for Phlebotomy Training

- The first day of class you must bring valid picture ID, Social Security card and resume.
- Criminal Backgrounds reviewed on case-by-case basis
- Able to lift 50 lbs.
- Required High School diploma or GED/High School Equivalency
